If you are lacking any kit then please see stores. Please arrive in civvies

To be worn or carried on person

RAF F3822 in a plastic bag	Boots DMS Hi-Legs
Pens/Pencils/Notepad/	Gloves/Hat
Medication if on Medical Form	Tissues
DPM/MTP Jacket, shirt & Trousers	Torch with spare batteries & Bulb.
Lots of clothing layers e.g.:- T-Shirt's, warm shirt, jumper (Sq n T-Shirt & Jumper)	Headover or Scarf
Sun tan creme	Waterproofs(top & bottom) don't have to be camo

To be carried in kit (large pack/rucksack)

Bivouac Kit	Spare Clothing
Sleeping Mat & Bag	2 T-Shirts
Extra Jumper & fleece	3 changes of socks & underwear

Other Kit	
Wash Kit hand towel/beer mat, toilet roll, soap, wet wipes, toothbrush/paste, razor and blades/electric.	Simple First Aid Kit: blister kit, moleskin, compeed or boots own 'blister' plasters. Antiseptic wipes & cream, plasters, insect bite cream/repellent.
Boot polish and brush	Needle & thread
Money to spend at the show (Optional)	Money for dinner on Friday night (Goring)

Notes:-

You must be able to carry all your kit

Pack your kit in plastic bags to keep it dry.

Make sure your sleeping bag is packed watertight or you will not sleep very well!

Food will be supplied but a few extra chocolate bars are always a good idea.
